STARTER PACKS

UNSCENTED LIP BALM

Chapped, dry lips are a result of treatment. Lip balm keeps lips from cracking and becoming painful.

CHILDREN'S TOOTHBRUSH

One effect of some chemotherapy treatments are sore and bleeding gums as well as mouth sores. A smaller toothbrush with soft bristles is gentler on the gums and mouth.

LAXATIVES

For some individuals, the irregularity caused by chemotherapy is an ongoing problem during the treatment process. The ClearLax helps keep one regular during treatment.

FLAVORED WATER

After just a couple of treatments, water has the tendency to have a metal flavor and/or it makes one nauseated. Flavored water is a healthy option.

DRY SKIN THERAPY LOTION

Dry skin from chemotherapy is a problem during treatment and long after. This product will also help with changes in skin during radiation.

SUGARLESS GUM

Dry mouth and nausea are common side effects of chemotherapy. Mint flavored gum provides relief for both side effects.
